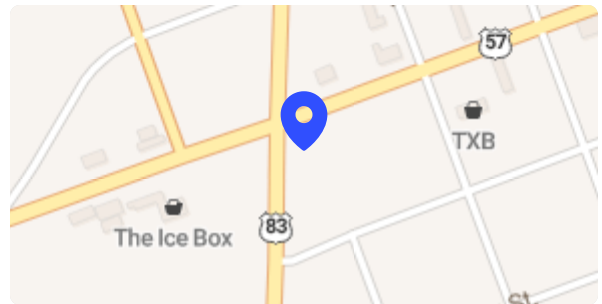

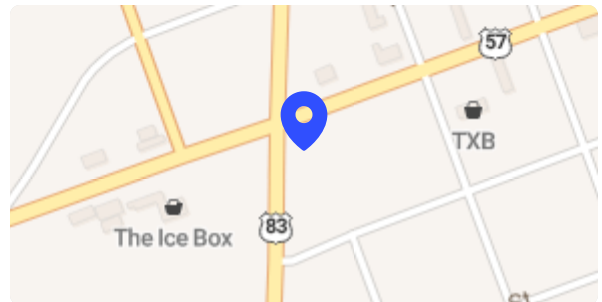

He came up to me during the worship, smiled and assured me everything would be okay. I didn't want or need counseling... those simple words spoken in compassion were enough to calm my soul. I'm grateful and honored he performed the wedding for my husband and I nearly 5 years ago on that calm August afternoon. When many people expressed doubt and apprehension about the marriage (largely because of finances), Rabbi Hall conveyed a simple reassurance that if Austin and I were to be together, God would orchestrate all the details. He helped us realize our decisions should not be made out of fear but rather trust. Over the years, we've realized the importance of this and it's helped to overcome any challenges and obstacles.
