Diego M. Gonzales, born March 5, 1935, in Uvalde, Texas, passed away peacefully on February 17, 2025, at Uvalde Memorial Hospital at the age of 89. He was the son of Maria Martinez and Jacinto Gonzalez Sr.

Diego worked as a laborer at various feed stores and packing sheds throughout his life. Though he kept to himself, he was known for his warm smile and quick wit.
